Your announcement during one of the Board meetings in Harrisburg about an earlier departure from the office of Executive Director came as a surprise. The foundation you established, putting the administration and operations of the WNGGA on a sound businesslike basis, will be of immense value whenever and wherever the International Headquarters is located. However, I doubt we will ever be able to find anyone who will be able to perform with the outstanding and rare degree of excellence you have exhibited.

The Welsh National Gymanfa Ganu Association, Inc., is a 501©(3) nonprofit organization with the stated purpose "To preserve, develop, and promote our Welsh religious and cultural heritage, including but not limited to the Gymanfa Ganu, and our religious and cultural traditions, and to do all things necessary and proper to accomplish and enhance the same".

The Executive Director's position is a voluntary, part-time position with the primary responsibility of managing the organization's Headquarters operation. The position carries an annual honorarium of \$5,000.00, with reimbursement of approved expenses. The WNGGA's International Headquarters will be established at the new Executive Director's convenience with the office of record remaining in Ohio.

The Director's responsibilities are:

To implement policy decisions set by the general membership, by the Board of Trustees, and the Officers and Executive Committee.

To provide communications services for the organization through the processing of correspondence, and the preparation and distributions of reports and minutes from organizational meetings.

To assist with ongoing membership recruitment efforts.

To coordinate the ongoing publications program for all items available through the international headquarters.

To supervise a support staff.

To work closely with the chairs and committees for the annual North American Festival including the Gymanfa Ganu and to coordinate arrangements as far as possible. and

To accept such other responsibilities as might be assigned by the Officers acting on behalf of the Board of Trustees.

Applicants must have been a Life Member of the WNGGA for at least three years, as of June 30, 2002 have a background in organizational management, and supports the goals and purposes of the WNGGA.
