Size of Sewer 6 INCH.

Average Depth 5'6"

W H E R E A S the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Cowbridge (hereinafter called "The Council") as the Local Authority for the said Borough propose, for the purpose of draining the said Borough, or part thereof, to lay and construct a Sewer consisting of a length of Cast Iron, Stoneware and Concrete Pipes a section thereof being of a diameter of between 3 inches and 21 inches.

A N D W H E R E A S the Engineers to the said Council have reported that it is necessary that the said Sewer shall be carried through or under certain lands (owned) *and* (occupied) by you being the premises hereinafter described :

A N D W H E R E A S it appears to the Council, having taken such Report into consideration, that it is necessary to carry the said Sewer through or under (your said land) (~~the said land~~ so occupied by you as aforesaid).


NOW THEREFORE TAKE NOTICE that the Council will under and in pursuance of the provisions of the above-named Act by their Contractor proceed to carry such sewer through or under (your said land) (~~the said land~~ so occupied by you as aforesaid) as indicated by the red line upon the accompanying plan, together with any necessary manholes relating to the said Sewer.

Plans showing the course of the said Sewer and all details connected therewith are deposited at the Town Hall, Cowbridge, and will until the *30th SEP. 1953* be open to your inspection during office hours.

A N D F U R T H E R T A K E N O T I C E that it is proposed to proceed with the said Works as soon as practicable after the *1st* day of *OCTOBER*, 1953.

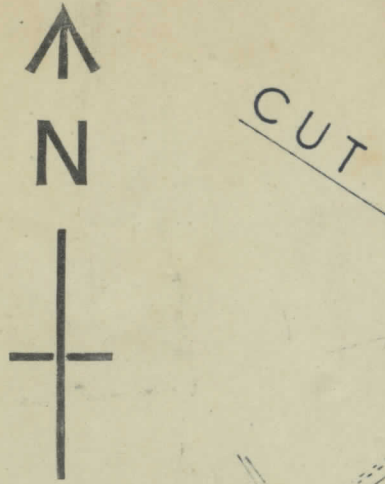
