EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE 1989 WELSH
NATIONAL GYMANFA GANU - PITTSBURGH
MINUTES OF MEETING DATED MARCH 21, 1989

The following individuals were present at the meeting: David R. Lewis, David Renshaw, Paul E. Stevens, Nelson Llewellyn, John Watkins, Dale Richards, Gloria Kondrat, Margaret Holingbaugh, Iris Rees, Margaret Rees, Frank Feeley, Becky Summers, and Jack Owen.

The meeting was called to order by David Lewis and the following individuals presented Committee reports.

I. Registration - Iris Rees

Iris reported that she has received 19 responses and approximately \$1900.00 in registration fees and contributions.

II. Marketplace - Gloria Kondrat

Gloria handed out a report which is attached to the official copies of these minutes. Gloria indicated that 4 exhibitors have reserved booths for the Marketplace. Gloria indicated that there may not be room for all the booths that are requested. The price of the booths was discussed, with a \$100 charge being suggested.

Gloria also spoke with Earl T. Williams, Jr. who suggested that the Welsh folk singing group "Mabsant" perform at the Gymanfa. Mr. Williams quoted a price of \$500 for the entire weekend, with one member of Mabsant agreeing to assist with the Children's Hour.

Mrs. Kondrat also included a letter from the Pittsburgh Hilton.

III. Hotel Arrangements - John Watkins

John indicated that an information release has been prepared for the Ninnau and Y Drach.

IV. Seminars - David Renshaw

David indicated that David Ponting will only be available to perform at the Gymanfa on Saturday. Mr. Ponting indicated that he needs a music stand and lights. It was suggested that the \$600 fee agreed to by David Renshaw with Mr. Ponting be reduced to some lower figure as he will only be presenting one seminar instead of two seminars.

David Renshaw mentioned that Dfyyd Iawn will replace David Ponting on the Friday seminar schedule. This will be reported in the second mailing letter and also should be included in the Ninnau and Y Drach. Mr. Renshaw further reported that he

was contacted by an individual from Winvest who reported that only 3 people visited their booth at the Baltimore Gymanfa. Request was made for us to attempt to publicize Winvest more. In addition, it was thought that non-Welsh and other business people may be interested in this program.

In connection with applications for a grant from the Pennsylvania Arts Council, Mr. Renshaw reported that newspaper clippings and letters of recommendation were being gathered, and other information prepared for the application. Jack Owen reported similar progress on an application with the Pittsburgh Foundation. Mr. Renshaw reported that the Ethnic Heritage Committee at the University of Pittsburgh, among other groups, will send a letter of recommendation.

V. Program - Dale Richards

Dale indicated that he needs pictures of the choir and other individuals participating in the Gymanfa for the program. It was also suggested that congratulatory letters from President Bush, Prince Charles, Governor Casey, and others be sought for the program.

The prices of advertising were discussed by David Lewis. It was suggested that we contact other groups regarding the prices which they charged in earlier Gymanfa bulletins. David Lewis quoted prices as follows:

\$500.00 - One Page
\$300.00 - Half Page
\$200.00 - Quarter Page
\$100.00 - Business Card

Dale noted that an advertisement has been sent to the St. David's Society of Connecticut, Inc. It was noted that all publicity should be coordinated through Dale.

VI. Nosen Lawen - Frank Feeley

Frank reported that he has written to the past three chairmen of this event. He hopes that he will receive information regarding the names and addresses of persons who participated in earlier Nosen Lawens. Frank intends for the Nosen Lawen to include professionals, if possible. It was noted that Mabsant could also be included in this event.

Frank suggested that the Nosen Lawen start at 8:00 p.m., with a 15 minute intermission at 9:00 p.m., and end at approximately 10:00 p.m. Frank suggested that the Nosen Lawen not last too late as this is a traveling date.

VII. Miscellaneous Items

1. David Lewis indicated that he need volunteer chairmen for the Saturday evening concert and the Gymanfa Ganu

sessions on Sunday. Iris Rees also expressed a need for someone to coordinate the banquet decorations on Friday night. David asked for names of people who could chair these events.

2. A banquet speaker for Friday evening was discussed. The following names were suggested: Morgan Roberts, Dr. Islyn Thomas and Jonathon Jones. No decision was reached on who should be contacted.

3. David Lewis noted that additional articles for the Ninnau and Y Drach were needed.

4. Iris Rees noted that there would be a price for the teacakes available at the next meeting.

5. David Lewis requested that each committee chairman present an outline, complete with names, addresses and telephone numbers of other committee members for the next meeting.

6. Nelson Llewellyn indicated the next two weeks are critical for submitting articles to the Ninnau and Y Drach and that much more publicity needs to be accomplished. Nelson further requested that the minutes be mailed to the Committee as soon as possible after the meeting. Nelson asked that the Committee begin preparing the second mailing letter.

Nelson reported that he had been in contact with Mr. Robin Jones and that he will be available for Master of Ceremonies. We need to communicate with Mr. Jones concerning his responsibilities. Nelson further mentioned that Mr. Jones has a problem with transportation, but that the Welsh Tourist Board has agreed to pay his travel expenses as long as the Executive Committee agrees to pay his hotel expenses.

7. Paul Stevens mentioned that the cost for insurance is only \$200.

8. A budget was prepared by David R. Lewis and is included as an official part of these minutes. This budget will be used in grant applications.
