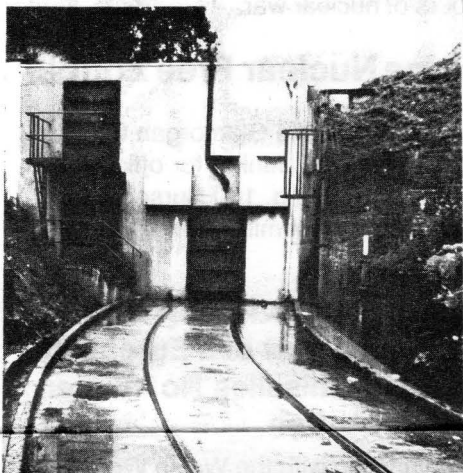


Keep Mid Glamorgan Nuclear Free!

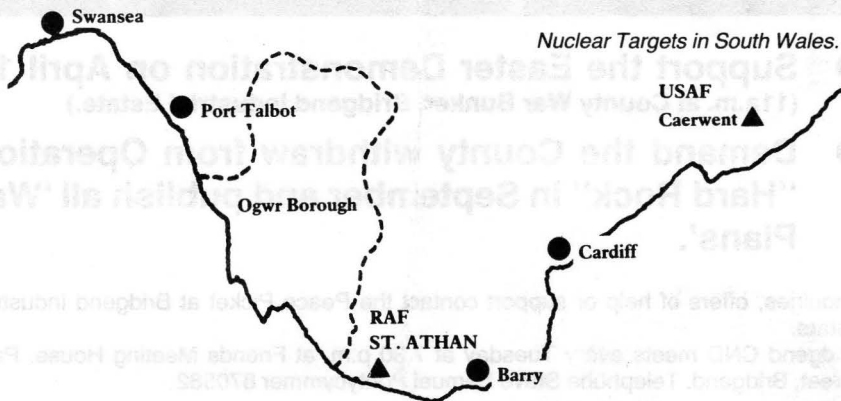
Government Bunker, Brackla Hill.

They know that Trident and US Cruise missiles will make Britain a prime target in what President Reagan believes could be "a limited nuclear war in Europe using tactical weapons".

In 1983 Cruise missiles will be stationed at Greenham Common. South Wales is less than 70 miles away and could be devastated by a nuclear attack on military and civil targets, as shown below:

The missiles and bunkers will not protect a single citizen. Indeed they may increase the risk of nuclear war by making it acceptable for the state to outlive the people.

CND says NO to Nuclear War Plans.



In September 1982 the government plans to rehearse for a nuclear war using the bunkers in Ogwr Borough in an exercise called Operation "Hard Rock." They are telling local authorities to bring their war plans and bunkers to "a higher state of readiness" i.e. within 48 hours of nuclear war.

Keep Mid Glamorgan a *Genuine* Nuclear Free Zone!

Despite soaring unemployment and cuts in services Mid Glamorgan County Council are spending a further £400,000 on their War Bunker for officials at Bridgend Industrial Estate. This money could provide e.g. 100 Nursery Staff, many more Home Helps for the sick and aged or school milk for the County's juniors.

CND opposes all spending for nuclear war and is campaigning for Wales and the UK to be part of a European nuclear free zone. CND says No cruise missiles No "Super Bunkers". Keep Mid Glamorgan Nuclear free.

We are taking non-violent action now in conjunction with the Welsh Womens Action for Life on Earth at Greenham Common and Brawdy. We call upon individuals, churches, community groups, peace organisations, trade unionists and the unemployed to support us.
