I arrived safe, & as soon as I left  
Merthyr Station I felt a lot better, so it must  
have been the air that was making me ill.  
I feel as right as rain now, & I hope you are the  
same. Tell dad that I havn't seen "Dick back,"  
yet, but I shall see him as soon as I can. I saw  
some wounded soldiers in Cheetor Station about 50  
of them, some being carried on stretchers. I was  
told by our officer today that I am getting my  
uniform this week, but I dont now wether it is  
blue or kachi. I shall have my potograph taken  
sometime next week, and will send a few  
to you. I have given half of those fags & to  
Chyvil, & said they were from you, so you  
must expect a letter from him thanking you  
for them. Letty shall have one of those potographs  
I hope Tom is alright, & not crying after me.  
I cant write any more now, or I would.
