*Whereas, March 1st is traditionally observed by people of Welsh origin as "Saint David's Day" to mark the life of Saint David, the patron saint of Wales; therefore be it*

*Resolved, That the House of Representatives designate March 1, 2018, as "Saint David's Day" in Pennsylvania.*
