I have had a letter from Davy and he says that Jack's lot are in the same part of the firing line, wouldn't it be fine if they met out there? Everythings going all right here and I like the life ~~and~~ and all the chaps up here. This photo is a rotten one but I am sending it on to give you an idea of the hut, that is only the top end ~~is~~ but as the other one is the same you can guess what the inside of a hut is like. Those two tins in front are the tea tins and that flat one between them is full of potatoes and beans, the light was bad and I am in the dark up in the corner there. I am also sending on a broach with our badge on it, you must excuse the packing as we havnt got any thin twine but it doesnt matter as long as you get it safely. We are getting on well with our training and I think we will soon be ready for the front. I cant write anymore now as the lights will be going out so good-bye until I write again.
