GENERAL REMARKS.

The Properties now offered for Sale comprise what is known as Mr. Owen Williams's NASH ESTATE, in the County of Glamorgan, the same for the purposes of Sale being divided into Lots, as set out in these Particulars.

The various Properties are situate near to the Market Towns of Cowbridge and Llantwit Major, and fourteen miles from the City of Cardiff.




Plan of Village of LISWORNEY
