

Farmers Arms, Aberthin

- 1851 Thomas Phillips, aged 50, victualler, wife Mary, son and daughter *Census 117*
- 1858 ? this property :
Sale by auction at the Horse & Groom of substantial dwelling house (4 bedrooms) and Malthouse close to it, plus cottage, in the village of Aberthin, on the side of the turnpike road leading to the station, Llantrisant and Pontypridd. *Bridgend Chronicle*
- 1861 Thomas Phillips, labourer and victualler, born St Andrews, wife Mary born Llanharri, daughter Ann 14 b. Llanblethian – Royal Oak *Census 176*
- 1863 Re-conveyance and re-lease – trustees of the General Reversionary and Investment Company to Major WP Richards of Llandaff House Esq., Royal Artillery : various land (in Cardiff especially) and two fields called Knapwg near Llanblethian church and the Royal Oak public house in Aberthin
