

Pant Wilkin, Aberthin

Early source : Lampard/Vachell papers in GRO.

- 1697 99 yr lease, William Gibbon of Llanharan gent to Jenkin Powell of Llanblethian yeoman – messuage and piece of land called Pant Wilkin *D/D Va 4 5/1*
- 1765 Lease, Grant Gibbon of Newton to William Humphreys of Cowbridge – Pant Wilkin *D/D Va 4 5/2*
- 1770 Sale, William Humphreys to Evan Symmons of St Hilary *D/D Va 4 5/3*
- 1780 Owner Evan Symmons; occupied by John Williams 8/8d *LTA*
- 1784 -7 Mr Evan Symonds owned; William John occupied 8/8d *LTA*
- 1786 William John 6/6d and 10/- P13/1 *Llb tithe*
- 1796 William John 10/- P13/1 *Llb tithe*
- 1799 *D/D Va 8*
- 1800 Simeon, gent, owner; William John occupier *Gloucester tithes*
- 1812-15 Evan Symmons owned; Thomas Butler occupied 8/8d *LTA*
- 1819 Lease, Evan Symmons to John Kayes of Cowbridge *D/D Va 4 5/7*
- 1829-31 Mr Evan Symonds, proprietor, to Mr John Kayes, Pant Wilkin farm 8/- *LTA*
- 1851 Death of Evan Harry of Pantwilkin, aged 12 *Welsh St Donats parish records*
- 1851 Evan Harry, thatcher, b Welsh St Donats, wife Jennet, 51, B WSD and son William, 14, plus father Evan, 74, pauper sieve maker, born Pendoylan *Census 134*
- 1861 Evan Harry, 58, thatcher, with wife Jennet and son William, butcher, unmarried, and granddaughter Mary Evans, 9, b Cowbridge *Census 160*
- 1871 Evan Harry, 70, gen labourer, with wife Jennet, 73, son Thomas 38, gen lab. and granddaughter Mary Harry 19, dressmaker *Census 104*

- 1874 Death of Evan Harry of Pantwilkin, aged 72 *Welsh St D parish records*
- 1878 Death of Jennet Harries of Pantwilkin aged 79 *Welsh St D parish records*
- 1881 Anne Evans, widow, 50, farmer of 15 acres, b Llb, with daughters Mary, 29 and Elizabeth, 10, and sons William, 18, Evan, 14, Christopher, 3, plus boarders Thomas Harry, 48, labourer and William Harry, 46, labourer *Census 111*
- 1891 John Evans, 65, farmer and labourer b Llancarfan, with wife b Llb and daughter Elizabeth, 21, domestic servant, b Llantrisant, and grandson Christopher b Llantrisant *Census 118*
- 1907 Death of John Evans of Pantwilkin aged 81 *Welsh St D parish records*
- 1911 Death of Annie Evans aged 79 *Welsh St D parish records*
- 1912 Death of Loder Williams Tanfield Vachell, owner Pantwilkin *D/D SA 3/686*
- 1919 Particulars of sale of Vachell estate, including Pantwilkin (tenant Mr F Rose), 16.063 acres *D/D C E/65*
- 1920 Farm conveyed to Mr Owen Williams of Crossways *D/D SA 3/686*
- 1924 Mr Frank Rose occupied; owner Owen Williams selling *D/D SA 2/686*
- 1949 Celebration of Golden Wedding of Mr FJ Rose of Pantwilkin. He was said to have been first a miller, then a collier, and latterly a farmer. He celebrated by going round all the Cowbridge pubs – pie-eyed by the time he got to the Farmers in Aberthin. His horse took him home. *WAH Fisher, Vol 69 p44*
