

### 30 High Street

*Nos 16 to 30 are grade II listed for their group value. All were originally Came properties, leased or conveyed by Richard Franklen of Clemenstone in 1830-40.*

*No 30 is described as 'early 19<sup>th</sup> century building on prominent site in conservation area and group value with adjacent listed buildings'.*

- 1828 Indenture of apprenticeship : Henry French, so of John French of Cardiff yeo.  
apprenticed to Robert Stibbs of Cowbridge baker and confectioner  
*29/xi/1828, indenture in Cowbridge museum.*
- 1834 Lease, Richard Franklen of Clemenstone to Robert Stibbs of Cowbridge –  
piece of ground on the eastern side and contiguous to the easternmost of  
dwelling houses of R Franklin  
*D/D Cl 1-17*
- 1841 (Re lease of 22-28 High Street) ground devised by R F on which R Stibbs has erected a  
dwelling house

- 1843 R Franklen, owned, Robert Stibbs, occ
