 amount of my Book debts taken all relative to be for
 the use and education of my daughter Jane and my
 son Thomas or any other that God may bless and
 will and desire that my aforesaid daughter Jane
 and my son Thomas or any other that God may
 bless and will may be sent apprentice to whatever
 Trade he or she may please provided the undiminished
 Executors agree it Item I will and desire that the money
 bequeathed to me by my late father Richard Glover
 of the County of Northampton that is to say fifty pounds
 one the seventeenth of July one thousand eight
 hundred and three and the sum of two hundred and
 fifty pounds remain to me at the death of
 my mother Jane Glover be appropriated to the
 aforesaid use Item I will and desire that my
 beloved wife Elizabeth partake of my effects in the
 same manner as my children as long as remains
 single but in case of her marrying again she
 shall the benefit of one hundred pounds at her
 death to be returned to my Executors or children Item
 I will and desire that my son or sons receive one
 fifth more than my daughter or daughters Item I
 nominate and appoint my brother Richard Glover
 and ~~brother~~ Mr. Benjamin Francis of Bristol in
 the County of Glamorgan my Executors made May
 the sixth in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and three as witness my hand
