To be buried within the Alderman's aisle of Cowbridge Church.

To his nephew Edward Bassett,.....?.

The dwelling house rented by David Thomas to his wife Catherine Bassett.

To his niece Mary Bassett, £10 to be paid within a year of death.

To his niece Alice John of Penlline, £10 to be paid within a year of death.

To his niece Catherine Portrey?, £10 to be paid within a year of death.

To his niece Mary Pierce?, £10 to be paid within a year of death.

To the Church at Cowbridge, £5 to be put to interest to glassing the windows in the Alderman's aisle.

To the poor of the town of Cowbridge, £5 to be put to interest to provide bread.

To the poor of Penlline 20s., the value thereof in bread to be distributed amongst them by his nephew Robert Williams of Cowbridge and William John of Penlline.

To his wife Catherine the customaryhold lands in Colwinston including those rented by his nephew Tomas Bassett of St. Hilary.

All the rest of his goods to his wife Catherine as executrix.
