Laudaff in the County of Glamorgan and a copy of
Laudaff, Roman Catholic

In the name of God Amen at or about the 20 day of February
Anno Domini 1660. the said Richard John being then sick and
bedrid but of perfect and disposing memory prayed to God
for his publick and private good left with and Testament
before the persons under named in manner and forme followinge
I myselfe to wit Thomas Jones to the lands of his wife
Catherine and Thomas Jones to wit Christ Jones and because
through his own merits to be eternally saved and his
body to be buried in Christian burials
I have to wit given and bequeath all his personal estate unto
his sonne Richard viz John Margrett William and
Mary to be equally divided amongst them excepting
one shilling and six pence which he has given to his son
William,
