in the County of Gloucestershire and Colledge of Sandars widow being of sound & perfect
memory and understanding do hereby give and bequeath unto my dear and lawfull
son Robert March all my moveables and household stuff and all my debts and
writing late my last will and testament in manner & form following (First)
I bequeath unto my son Robert all my moveables and household stuff and all my debts
his share and the residue of what I shall die seised of and my body to
the parish church of Lambetham aforesaid.

Item I do give and bequeath unto the poor of Lambetham aforesaid the
sum of ten shillings to be paid yearly forever and the increase thereof
of ten yearly at the discretion of the churchwardens and vestry of the said
parish among such of the said poor of Lambetham aforesaid as shall be chosen in next
yearly, Item I bequeath unto my son Robert Grant five shillings in
revenue of my house and bequeath unto my grandchild John Grant two barren sheep
and to his sister Joan Grant four barren sheep in remembrance of me
the Rent and Return of all my goods Cattle and chattels of what kind
and nature soever they be of I bequeath unto my son Lewis Grant of
Lambetham aforesaid for his use and behoof by no manner of title and
appoint sole Executor of this my last will and testament the said Lewis
Grant being already appointed to be paid and delivered within one year after
my decease and I do hereby disannull and revoke all former or other
wills or wills by me heretofore made and this only shall be my last
will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and
Seal the one and twentieth day of August in the Eleventh year of the Reign
of our Sovereign Lord King William the Third of England &c. Anno Domini 1699.
