

The will of Morgan Rees, yeoman, of Llanblethian dated 18th August 1707.

To his stepson William Bassett, all his wearing apparel immediately after his death and funeral.

To his stepdaughter, Margaret Bassett, a suit of wearing apparel to be made out of the piece of stuff which he had brought with him out of Holland. This was to be done immediately after his death and funeral. If the executors of the will failed to do so then they were to pay Margaret 20s.

His wife Jenett was to be the executrix of the will.

deliver unto my said ^{only} Daughter & said Suit of
Coathes to be made up as aforesaid then my Exor.
shall and will pay unto my said ^{only} Daughter
the Sum of Twenty Shillings The Cash I do
hereby Revocable constitute and appoint my Loving
wife Jonett my whole and sole Exor. of this my
last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have this
18th Day of August the Sixth year of Queens Ann Reign
Shew'd this 1707 Set my hand & Seal.
