Having surrendered $9^{1/2}$ acres of customary lands called Caia Hwnt at the Court Barron held 15th., May 1707, he grants the land to Thomas Wilkins of Llanblethian, gent, according to the custom of the manor, in trust to raise £50 within a year of death to be used as follows.

£10 towards funeral expenses.

To his nephew Robert Sweeting £5 10s.

To his niece Elizabeth Sherie? £3.

To his nephew Richard Jenkin £3.

To his niece Maud Sweeting £3.

To his nephew William Sweeting 10s.

To his nephew Morgan William, 5s To Richard Morgan, Morgan William's brother, 5s.

To William Morgan, the younger brother, 5s.

To his old maid servant Jane Howell, £7 10s. Also the feather bed and appurtenances, a brass pan, tongs and shovel.

To his nephew, Robert Sweeting, his best suit of wearing apparel.

His customary heir and nephew, Charles Bassett to be executor.
