All his goods to his son in law, William Morris and Gwenllian his wife.  
Thomas Wilkins was appointed executor.

In the Name of God Amen.

I Thomas Lewis of Louy Lan in the parish of  
Lambethan in the County of Glamorgan being Sick in  
body but of sound and perfect memory Do make  
this my last Will revoking all former Wills by me  
made. I hereby recommend my Soul to Almighty  
God and my body to ye Grave. And as for my  
worldly goods I give and bequeath all my  
goods and Chattels of what kind or nature soever  
they be to my Son in Law William Morris  
and Geroulan my Daughter and his wife. And  
Do nominate constitute and appoint my  
Loving friend Mr Thomas Withins of Lambethan  
attendant the Executor of this my last Will and  
Testament In Trust for my Said Son in Law  
and his Said Wife. In Witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and Seal this 14<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785
