His debts and funeral expenses to be discharged.

I Glamorgan latter, being weak and sick in body, but of good and perfect memory, do make and ordain this my present last will and Testament in manner and form following (That is to say) First I commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, hoping through the merits, death and passion of my Saviour Jesus Christ to have full pardon and remission of my sins, and to inherit everlasting life; And my body I commit to earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named; And as touching the disposition of all such temporall Estate, as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me, I give and dispose thereof as followeth; First, I will that my Debts and funerall expences shall be paid and discharged; First I give and bequeath the corner cupboard unto David Jones of Anblithian Cordwainer; Also I give and bequeath to my brother David the sum of one Shilling; Also I give and bequeath to my brother Thomas one Shilling; Also I give and bequeath to my brother William one Shilling; Also I give and bequeath to my sister Elizabeth one Shilling; All the rest and residue of my personall Estate, Goods and Chattis whatsoever, I do give and bequeath unto my loving nephew Nicholas Within of Llanarvan Carpenter, which said Nicholas Within, I nominate and appoint to be whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament; In Witness whereof I the said Evan James have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand and Seal this fifteenth day of December in the year of our Lord God, one thousand seven hundred and sixty one, The mark of Evan James. Signed and Sealed, Published and Declared by the Testator Evan James in the presence of us, Richard John, Thomas Jones.
