

A bond concerning the estate of Elizabeth Nicholls of Llanblethian, spinster dated 23<sup>rd</sup> October 1762. The executrix named was Joan Deere of Llanblethian ,widow, the other named being David Williams of Llanblethian, gentleman. The bond was for a sum of £100.



ANNO MCLXIIII by these presents that we John Deere of the parish of Llandaff  
in the County of Glamorgan widow and David Williams of the  
same parish Gospetman

are become bound unto the right Honourable Father in God John — by divine permission Lord Bishop  
of Llandaff in the Sum of One Thousand .. .. pounds of good and lawful money of great  
Brittain to be paid to the said Lord Bishop or his lawful assigns his Ex: & Rev: & Clerks or quire  
for the yearly payment of which sum will truly to be made weekly an allowance of twelve shillings per  
the week as heretofore by these presents settled with our selves Dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> Day of  
October 1762 ..

The condition of this obligation is such that if the above-bounden John Deere the  
widow and exec of His and Administratrix of all and singular the good  
Chattels and Credits of Elizabeth Nichols late of the parish of Llandaff  
in the County of Glamorgan and Diocese of Llandaff Minister  
deceased do make or cause to be made a true & perfect Inventory of all singular the good Chattels & Credits of the said  
deceased to have or that come to the hand possession or knowledge of the said John Deere .. ..  
or into the hand & possession of any other person or persons for her and the same so made do exhibit  
or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the Consistory Court of Llandaff at or before the last  
Day of January next ensuing and the same good Chattels & Credits  
and all other the good Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which at the time of her Death was  
at any time after shall come to the hand & possession of the said John Deere .. ..  
or into the hand & possession of any other person or persons for her do use  
and truly administer according to law; And further do make or cause to be made a true just  
Account of her said Administration as or before the last Day of October  
which will be in the year 1763 and at the cost and charge of the said good Chattels & Credits  
which shall be found remaining upon the said Administratrix Account the same being  
first examined and allowed off by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall  
deliver and pay unto such person or persons respectively as the said Judge by his Decree  
sentence pursuant to the true intent and Meaning of an act of Parliament intituled an act for the better  
settling of Testators Estates shall direct & appoint; And of hereafter it shall appear that any last will  
and Testament was made by the said deceased and the Ex: or Ex: therein named do exhibit the  
same into the said Court making request to have it approved off accordingly if the said John Deere  
being therunto lawfully required do render and deliver the same to the said Court  
to be void of no effect or else remain in full force and Virtue. The sum of
