To his wife Sarah Sweeting and her customary heirs, a customaryhold messuage, stable and garden together with two parcels of customaryhold land in Aberthin, in the manor of Llanblethian, mortgaged to William Bowen of Llantwit Major, yeoman, for the sum of £50 plus interest and surrendered in the manor court for such use. The rest of his goods to his wife Sarah as executrix.
