

The will of Eustance Miles, yeoman, of Llanblethian, dated 14th November 1771.

To his sister, Mary Miles, spinster, three pounds to be paid within a month after his death.

The rest of the estate to his wife Margaret Miles as executrix.

In the Name of God, Amen. I Eustance Miles of the
Parish of Llanblethian in the County of Glamorgan, Yeoman,
being weak in Body, but of sound and perfect Mind and
Memory, blessed be Almighty God for the same, do make
and publish this my last Will and Testament in Manner and
Form following (that is to say) First, I deliver my Body
to the Ground from whence it was taken, to be decently buried
at the Discretion of my Executrix hereinafter mentioned, and my
Soul, (that immortal part of me) I deliver into the Hands of my
merciful Creator, hoping through the Merits and Mediation of
of my dear Saviour & Redeemer Jesus Christ, to receive full &
perfect Remission of all my Sins. As touching that Share of
worldly Goods, I am endowed with, I give and bequeath the same
as followeth. First, I give and bequeath to my dear Sister
Mary Miles, Single Woman, the Sum of Three Pounds of
Lawfull Money of Great Britain to be paid her within
a month after my Decease by my Executrix. And lastly, as to all
the Rest, Residue and Remainder of my personal Estate, Goods
and Chattels, of what ^{kind} or Nature soever I give and bequeath the
same to my beloved Wife Margaret Miles, whom I hereby
appoint Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament;
hereby revoking all former Wills by me made. In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this
fourteenth Day of November in the Year of our Lord, one
Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy One

his last Will & Testament in the pres-
