

The will of David Thomas, yeoman, of Llanblethian dated 5th January 1774.

To his daughter Anne the sum of £20 when she reached the age of 21.

To his daughter Jane the sum of £20 when she reached the age of 16.

The rest of the estate to his wife Anne as executrix.

In the Name of God Amen
I David Thomas of the Parish of Lambeth-
ian and County of Glamorgan Yeoman, am in per-
fect mind and memory do make and Ordain this
my last Will and Testament:

First I recommend my Soul unto the Hands of God
my Creator and my Body to be Buried in the Earth
from whence it cometh, as a Decent Christian Burial,
and as touching such Worldly Estate as the Lord of his
goodness hath blessed me with I give and bequeath in
the following manner and form.

Viz, I give ^{devise and bequeath} to my Dear Daughter Anne the Sum
of Twenty Pounds of lawfull British Money to be
paid her by my Executrix herein after named
when she shall attain to the Age of Twenty and One Years.
Item, I give devise and bequeath unto my Dear
Daughter Jane the Sum of Twenty Pounds of
lawfull British Money to be paid her by my
Executrix herein after named when shee attains
to the Age of Twenty and One Years.

Item I give devise and bequeath unto my Dear
Son Thomas the Sum of Twenty Pounds to be
paid him by my Executrix herein after named when
he attains to the Age of Sixteen Years.

All the rest of my Goods Chattels and personall
Estate I give and bequeath unto my Dear Wife
Anne whom I appoint Sole Executrix of this my
last Will revoking all former Wills by me made
In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my Hand
and Seal this Twenty Fifth day of January in the
Year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and
Seventy Four.
