are come bound unto the Right Reverend Father in God & His Grace by Divine permission  
Lord Bishop of Landaff in the sum of five hundred pounds of good and lawfull  
Money of Great Brittain to be paid to the said Lord Bishop or his lawful attorney his heirs  
assigns or assigns for the good and faithful payment of which sum well and  
truly to be made Wm bind over selves and each of us jointly and severally for the whole  
our heirs heirs and assigns firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated the  
fourteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty

The condition of this obligation is such that if the above bounden Richard Gaffer the  
Natural and lawfull son and one of the Next of kin and Administrator of all  
and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of Richard Gaffer late of  
the parish of Lambethan in the County of Glamorgan and Diocese of  
Landaff Deceased

do make or Cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods Chattels  
and Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession and knowledge  
of the said Richard Gaffer or into the hands and possession of any other  
person or persons for him and the same so made do exhibit or Cause to be exhibited into  
the Registry of the Consistory Court of Landaff on or before the last day of March  
next ensuing and the same Goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which at the  
time of his death or which at any time hereafter shall come to the hands and possession  
of the said Richard Gaffer or into the hands and possession of any other  
person or persons for do well and truly Administer according to Law and further  
do make or Cause to be made a true and perfect Out of his said Administration on  
or before the last day of December which will be in the year 1781 and all the  
rest and residue of the said Goods Chattels and Credits which shall be found remain-  
ing on the said Administrator's account the same being first examined and allowed of  
by the Judge of the said Court for the time being shall deliver and pay unto such  
person or persons respectively as the said Judge by his decree or sentence pursuant to the  
true intent and meaning of an Act of Parliament (intituled an Act for the better settling Intestate  
Estates) shall limit and appoint and hereafter it shall appear that any last will and  
Testament was made by the deceased and the heir or heirs the said named do exhibit the  
said will to the said Court making request to have it approved of the said Court  
Richard Gaffer being thereunto lawfully required do render and deliver the  
said Letters of Administration or Probation of such Testament being first had and made into  
the said Court then this obligation to be void and of no effect or else to remain in full virtue

 this my Renunciation and pray the same to be admitted and  
 enacted; And I do hereby promise to Allow for firm and Valid all  
 and whatsoever my said Proctor shall lawfully do or cause to be  
 done for me and in my Name in and touching the premises & In  
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this  
 Twelfth Day of Decembar in the year of our Lord One Thousand  
 Seven Hundred and Eighty. /

 lawfully constituted in the presence of  
 the undersigned Notary Publick.

Lawfully of business of renouncing the

the said Surrogate prays and the said Surrogate at  
his petition admitted the said specific prayer and  
remuneration exhibited as aforesaid, as far as  
by Law may be admitted and enacted, and  
thereupon desired that the said Surrogate be  
granted: And then the said Surrogate personally Richard  
Gutber and allowed that the said deceased departed  
this life somewhat more than a year without making  
any will, as above expressed, that he is the natural  
and lawful son and one of the next of kin of  
the said deceased, who after he died and the  
said Surrogate at his petition desired that the  
said administration of all and singular the goods  
chattels and credits of the said deceased be  
granted and committed to him, giving sufficient  
security for the same, he having first taken  
an Oath, as well concerning the truth of the  
premises, as also of his due and faithful  
Administration of the personal Estate of his said  
Father deceased, and that the goods, Chattels and  
Credits of the said deceased did not amount  
in value to the sum of three hundred pounds.
