will and testament in manner and forme following
First I commend my soule into the hands
of the allmighty god my maker and redemer
and my body to be buried in Christian burrell

I give and bequeath unto Mary water my
daughter 1st of give and bequeath unto Agnes my
daughter 2^d of give and bequeath unto Ann my
daughter 3^d of give and bequeath unto Jane
my daughter 4th of give and bequeath unto
Robert my son 5th of give and bequeath unto
the Cathedral Church of Landaph, 6th of give and
bequeath unto the repair of St. Peter's man-
church 7th of give to the vicar for my be-
nefitted child, 8th of give toward the repair of my
parish church 9th of give to the vicar of my said parish
for my forgotten child, 10th of give toward the repair
of St. Peter's man^{or} one bussell of beane to be
divided betwixt them and halfe a bussell of
corne to be divided betwixt the poore of my said
parish, I give also unto Cypell Thomas one part of
waxe and unto Robert Gronow halfe an ounce of waxe

Item my will is that the said Cypell and Robert
and my legacies be truly paid (as for a record here)
by the executing of my last will and testament
after all my debts by specialties and other ways payd,
the rest of all my goods and chattes moveable and
immoveable I give and bequeath unto Ann Water
