bearing the third day of May in the year of our Lord god
1636: made published and declared in the presence of
good men and worthie gentlemen Richard and William
Richard as follows: first 50 pence towards the Church wall
of St Marys Hill 50 pence towards the reparation
of St Marys Hill Church 50 pence towards
bequeathed to William Richard ^{his} son one Cowe two
yearlings and ten sheep. Item ~~50 pence~~ and bequeathed
to Ann Richard ^{his} daughter two cows two yearlings and
ten sheep. Item ~~50 pence~~ and bequeathed to
John Richard one sheep and one lamb. Item ~~50 pence~~ and bequeathed for
the rest of his goods rattles rattles unqueathed both
movable and unmovable unqueathed unto Margarett
John his best beloved wedded wife Edward Richard
of Daniell Richard his son be gotten by the said Margarett
to be equalled divided between them three & finally did
nominate & appoint Margarett John his love said wedded
wife to be executor of his last will & testament in
