of Hereford - 16 I do give and bequeath the sum
of 1000 £ for Thomas the great brason gun the best
brason gun, also lead and all the lead the said
in the said the Robert and the timber in the said
the wish, all loose plankes and timber that lyeth within
my gunns one more each of two years next after my decease
at the outes that are in Carlough barrow two acres and half
an acre of ground of Thomas Robert of S. Maryhill, for
the term of two next years, beginning at Michaelmas
next following, for consideration whereof I do give
Some £ for Thomas, to give unto my Some John Thomas
the sum of ten pounds in manner following, viz:
five pounds within one twelve month next after my decease,
and the other five pounds at the end of two years next
after my decease, And to I do give one bond that I stand
thereof, I do give ^{for the redemption} of some pounds with the interest
unto my Some John Thomas six pounds, viz: three pounds
at the end of one twelve month next after my decease, and
the other three pounds at the end of two years next after

I do give and bequeath to my some thornes or
thornes one sheaf of land which I bought from Sir
Edward thornes upon seventene acres and one half an acre
of land all lying within the parish of Tunstun
during the termes of the said lease, I do give
and bequeath to my said some thornes or thornes all
the rest and residue of all my goodd chattels and
moveable and immoveable goods before not bequeathed,
and do hereby nominate appoint and ordaine my
said some thornes or thornes, to be my sole executor
of this my last will and testament, further more
if in case that the more shall before bequeathed
unto my some thornes or thornes, be taken for a bequest
that he maye give to the use of any other bequest or
