In the name of God Amen, the three and twentieth day of february  
in the yere of our Lord God, 1683. I Lewis William of Fouldin in  
the County of Cambridg, and Dioces of Lundregh, being sick in  
body but of good and perfect memory thank be to God, doe make  
and ordaine this my last will and testament, in manners & forme  
following, first I comitt my soule to allmighty God, my  
only maker and redeemer, and my body to be buried in Christian  
buriall, I do give and bequeath to my grandchildren Margheret  
William and Mary William the daughters of William Lewis, my  
best friend, my best charyson, brother and my best friend,  
I do give and bequeath to my grandchild Mary Robert, the great  
grand wif of our father Robert Tonkin, and one giffes  
of great wif, she is comyng to 15 yeres yet out, and two ewes,  
I do give and bequeath to my grandchild Symonny Wilkin  
one steere comyng to three out, I do give, bequeath and demise,  
to my sonne Robert Lewis two acres of land lying within 50  
yds of Fouldin, aforesaid, comonly called and knowne by the  
name of Dwy ewe, or, Dwyther, for his life tyme, and after his  
decease unto my sonne William Lewis for ever, I do give  
bequeath and demise, unto my sonne William Lewis, one acre  
of meadow land comonly called and knowne by the name of ewe  
flew y flow, at Fouldin aforesaid, ymmediatly after my decease  
for ever, I do give, bequeath, and demise, to my grandchild  
Joan Robert, one messuage, one garden, and one acre of land  
being now in the occupation and possession of Sewell Foster  
of Fouldin aforesaid, to have and to hold to her messuage,  
garden, and the said acre of land for ever, one better hat  
lyng in the galle, one dust bed one plain timber bed, one  
feather bolster, one dust bolster, and the rest of the things  
that doe appertaine to it, ymmediatly after my decease, and after  
the decease of my wedded wife Margheret Lewis, I do give  
and bequeath to Edward the sonne of Alexander Savoy, one  
steere yeresling, I do give and bequeath to my grandchild  
Joan Wilkin, one <sup>ewe</sup> and lambe, I do give and bequeath to my  
grandchild Joan Robert one ewe and lambe, I do give and  
bequeath to my sonne William Lewis the three yeresling  
of my sheepe, that is to say, one standing bedstead,

the best and table that lyeth in ye full the fourth  
board and payer bouster and all ye rest of ye table  
yeat deplaine to it w<sup>ch</sup> cometh by ye nose, flower powder  
platter, one bouster stande strike, y<sup>m</sup>mediately after ye  
servise of my selfe and <sup>the</sup> servise of Margaret  
Yeombe my wife,

I do give and bequeath all the rest and residue of  
my good chattell, and ~~the~~ <sup>the</sup> goods now not bequeathed  
betwene my wedded wife Margaret Yeombe, and my  
sonne Robert Lewis, And doo hereby ordaine, nominate  
and appoint my said wife Margaret Yeombe, and  
my said sonne Robert Lewis, to be Joynt Executors  
of yis my last will and testament, w<sup>ch</sup> I do put
