I give and bequeath to the said David Harey  
of harrows I give my two colles and whereof in the garden  
and the other wye is upon the left side I give one pen  
I give one horse wye is the best I give to my daughter in  
law Joane Baylyt one french bed wye is in the hall I give  
bequeath to my said sonne David Harey a breeches and a coat I give and  
I give of all the rest of my goods be staffes and beathles movable  
and unmovable not afore bequeathed I give to Alexander Harey  
whom I nominate and appoint the whole and sole executor of this  
my last will and testament
