Will dated 31st March 1666

Bequests

three acres of land bought of Richard Thomas, to his wife Elizabeth for her natural life and after to his youngest son Thomas Jenkin.

A condition that on inheritance of the land Thomas must pay five pounds to his sister Jenet Jenkin and five pounds between Jenkin Robert and Anne Robert the children of his brother Robert Jenkin.

To his daughter Elizabeth, two cows and ten sheep which are with his son-in-law David Hopkin.

To his daughter Mary, five pounds.

To his daughter Jane Jenkin, five pounds.

To the poor of the parish wherein I live, (Penlline) five shillings.

His wife Elizabeth to be sole executor of the will .

In the name of god Amen the last day of march 1666 according  
to the computation of the Church of England of Guntin Thomas the elder  
of Penllin-y-doman in the County of Glamorgan being of perfect me-  
mory and understanding do make and ordaine his my last will and testa-  
ment in manner and forme following

First I give and bequeath my soul into the hands of the Almighty  
god my maker hoping that through the meritorious death and passion  
of Jesus Christ my only saviour and redemptor to receive forgiveness  
for all my sinnes and as for my body to be buried in Christian buriall at  
the discretion of my executrix hereafter nominated

First I bequeath three acres of land which I bought of Richard Thomas  
unto Elizabeth my wife during the term of her naturall life and after her  
decease unto Thomas Guntin my youngest sonne and to the right heirs of his  
body for ever upon condition that he shall pay five poundes unto my daughter  
Jonest Guntin and five poundes more to the widow Jontin Robert And Anne  
Robert the children of Robert Guntin my eldest sonne at the outting in  
or first possession of the said land to my daughter Elizabeth two cows  
and two sheep after my decease which I have with my sonne in law David  
Hopkin of Glamorganshire my daughter Mary five poundes. I give unto my  
daughter Jane Guntin five poundes. I give five shillings unto the  
poore of the parish where I live. I make Elizabeth my wife my sole  
executrix upon all my goods and rattell household stuffe sheep and horses  
and all that I have upon the parts upon condition that shee shall  
I forme his my last will and Testament and pay all my debts and legacies  
whatsoever notvoking all other wills and testaments In witness whereof  
I have hereunto put my hand and seale the day and year first  
above written
