Will dated 22nd April 1666.

In the name of god Amen I Robert Egmond of
~~County of Flanders~~ in the County of Flanders and
 Diocese of Cambrai, your an beinge first in body
 but of the firste person, I praye to be unto all things by
 god for it doo make, and stande by my last will
 and testament in writinge, in manner and forme
 followinge first I bequeath my soule unto all things by
 god my matter and redowde; and my body to be buried
 secretly amongst my ancestors in the churche of
 Ghent. Also for my necessaries goods I doo devise, give
 and bequeath my anffuare and household stuffe of
 derbyng carbuncle of greeke unto my deareste son
 for so long tyme that they with the profit and profite
 thereof shall pay my debts, and after the payment of my
 debts I doo bequeath the mayty of ~~the~~ said messuages
 lands and tenements unto my lovinge ~~and~~ duringe the tyme
 of your naturall life if the lease for long tyme, and after
 your decease I doo give the said messuages unto my dearest
 sonne Robert and his assigns duringe the said
 lease, and so for the other mayty of the said messuages lands
 and premises of doo devise and bequeath it unto my said sonne
 for so long tyme and until the some of five poundes
 of lawfull Englysh money be also payed, ^{out} ~~leaved~~ of the profit
 and profite of the premises aforesaid for charge of my sayde
 children, and after the leynge and sayyinge of five poundes
 apeece for charge of my said youngest children I give
 my said dearest sonne Robert and his assigns duringe
 the said lease. Lastly I nominate, institute, and appointe my
 lawfull wife Hieronima dauid and eldest sonne Egmond
 to receive care and trust of the residue of my laste and
 testament and to receive of bequeath all the rest of my goods.

In witness whereof I gave order unto subscribed my
hands and set my seal the 25th day of April in the
eighteenth year of the reign of our sovereign
lord Charles the first by the grace of god King of
England, Scotland, France, and Ireland, Defender of
the faith &c. Anno Domini 1666.
