 year of our Lord God one thousand six hundred thirtie seven  
 I Morgan Lewis of the parish of Worth & Donant, in the Count of  
 Glamorgan and Dioc of Landaffe, beinge sick in Bedde, but whole  
 in minde, thankes be to Almighty God therofore, doe make  
 and ordains his my Last will and Testament in w<sup>ch</sup> I doe  
 Mandre and forme followinge, vizt first I doe by these w<sup>ch</sup>  
 Abrogate and disannull all former w<sup>ch</sup> by me made before  
 the date hereof, and most humbly Comitt my soule to the  
 Almighty; and my Bodie to be buried in the parish Church of  
 Worth & Donant, first I give and bequeath unto the  
 Goddall Church of Landaffe vizt Item I doe give and  
 bequeath to the parish Church of Worth & Donant vizt I  
 doe give and bequeath unto Eirenellian don vizt I doe give  
 and bequeath to the said woman vizt I doe give and  
 bequeath to my Exaunder child Morgan Mathoc twoe acres of  
 Land of Land that is within the parish of Worth & Donant,  
 one acre and an halfe on the west side of a close called Tyla

 and a Cabbone, I give and bequeath to Margaret Daniell  
 twoe Coffins, one Coffin that is above on the left, and the  
 other that is below, the said Morgan Mathoc when he  
 cometh to his full age shall pay to his sister Catherine  
 Mathoc five poundes; I doe give by my last will and Testament  
 Daniell Resser to be my sole executor of this my  
 Last will and Testament
