shillings. Item I give and bequeath the sum
^{ten} shillings to be distributed amongst
the poore, of the sd parish of ystowowan the
27th day of November next. Item I give and
bequeath the sum of 4^l - 9^s due to give from
Morgan Edward of the parish of ystowowan, to be
employed to my nestery of ^{and the vicars}
City (if any be) to be employed by ^{the vicars}
namely. Item I give and bequeath unto Christopher
William of Lanher my nephew and ^{two} year old
two yearlings. Item I bequeath all the rest
of my Cattle and my horse towards the paymg of
my Debt. Item I give and bequeath all my
shoope if any be betwix Mary Jonkin and Johan
Deere. Item I give and bequeath the two yiggs that
