to John Jenkin of the parish of Walth & Donat in the county
of Glamorgan and Diocese of Landaff yeoman the benefitted
servant of Almighty god, being sick in body but graciously
godly of perfect mind and memory do make and declare
this my last will and testament in manner following In witness
with a free and willing heart I render and give again my
soul into the hands of Almighty god my Creator and redeemer
assuredly hoping for salvation through the only merits of
my redeemer Christ Jesus, And my body to Christian Curiall
Item I give to the Cathedrall church of Landaff aforesaid one
shilling Item I give to the parish church of Walth & Donat
aforesaid ten shillings and ten shillings to the poor of the
said parish of Walth & Donat Item upon condition that my third
son John Jenkin shall truly pay or cause to be paid to my daughter
Mary Jenkin sixteen pounds of English money in manner following
that is to say five pounds thereof within one whole year next after
my decease, the like sum of five pounds within two whole years
next after my decease, and six pounds of gold and ^{gold} residue before
the full end of three years next after my decease. Then and
upon that condition I give and bequeath to my said son John
Jenkin one old standing bedsted in my Inner chamber, two great
trunks in my hall And all the householdstuff that I had by
my late deceased wife. And my will is, that if my said daughter
Mary shall happen to die before the full payment of the said
legacy of sixteen pounds, that then so much thereof as shall
be unpaid at the time of her decease shall remain to my daughter
Katharine Jenkin, Item in case my said son John or his executor
shall make default of the payment of the said legacy of sixteen pounds
in manner herein before expressed, then my will is and I give and
bequeath all and singular the herein before mentioned householdstuff to
my said daughter, Mary, Item I give and bequeath to my said daughter Mary

one front bedd one feather bed and its appoyntments, one
gowne Baker, one gowne sup, Item upon condition that my eldest
son Lewis Jordan his heirs or executor shall truly pay or cause to
be paid to my said daughter Mary within one whole year next after
that is to say sixe monthes thereof within one whole year next after
my decease, sixe monthes within the end of two whole years next
after my decease and sixe monthes yett and residue thereof within
the space of three years next after my decease, Then and upon
that condition I give bequeath and devise to my said son Lewis
Jordan and his heirs forever one acre of free land
being meadow ground lying by the house of John Berolmi
in Mohk of Donat aforesaid, And in default of payment
of the said sixe monthes legacie to be paid in manner aforesaid
then I give devise and bequeath to my said daughter Mary her
executor and assigns the said acre of meadow ground for and
during the full term of Nineteen years next after my decease at
the yearly rent of one penny to be paid to my heirs at Mustantow
(if demanded) during the said term, Item I give and bequeath to my
said son Lewis two hit that one is my two sword brace with
one brace sheel and all my household stuff and utensils of household
of what sort soever they be, ^{in my will in default aforesaid} Item I give to my son in law Miles John
one man full of three years old, Item I give to my said daughter
Mary one heifer going to three years old, Item I give to my said
daughter Katharine one heifer of the same age, Item I give to my
sixe sons one house with a garden, Item upon condition that my son
John Jordan shall truly pay or cause to be paid to my said daughter
Katharine her executor or assigns the sum of ten pounds before the end
of four years next after my decease, Then and upon that condition
I give devise and bequeath to my said son John Jordan and his customary
heirs forever one acre of customary hold land lying within the parish
of Mohk of Donat aforesaid in manner of Calaban in as ample manner
as I purchased by same of Whilkey David lately deceased And in
case my said son John or his heirs shall make default of payment
of the said legacie of ten pounds to be paid in manner herein before expressed
then I give devise and bequeath the said acre of customary land to my
my said daughter Katharine her customary heirs forever, Item upon condition

Witness my hand and seal this 10th day of March 1608

that my aforesaid son Lewis his heirs executors or assigns shall truly pay
to my sons Richard Jenkin, Roger Jenkin, Will Jenkin and my daughter
Katherine Jenkin fifty shillings a year in manner following that is
to say fifty shillings to my said son Richard within one year next after
my decease, fifty shillings to my said son Roger within two years next
after my decease, fifty shillings to my said son Will within three
years next after my decease, And fifty shillings of residue of the said ten
pounds to my said daughter Katherine within the end of four years
next after my decease, Then and upon that provision & give devise &
bequeath to my said son Lewis and his customary heirs forever
one house called the great house one orchard, one garden and two
littl. houses now in decay adjoining to the said great house together
with two pieces of land by containing in G. which about one half
are lying at a place called gen crok and one other piece
of lands containing about one half are called ex hancum two
pall Marke the same being all customary lands lying in G.
parish of Moleh & Donat aforesaid and Mannor of Calatan
aforesaid. And in default of payment of the said legacy of ten pounds to
my said four children in manner herein before expressed, Then & do give
devise and bequeath the said customary lands & premises to my said
three sons and daughter viz Richard Roger, Will, and Katherine
and their customary heirs forever, All the rest & residue of my
goods chattels and whatsoe hereby before not given, & give devise
and bequeath to my said two sons Lewis and David whom
I make nominate and appoint my Joynt executors, heartily
enjoyning them to be truefull in the performance of this my last
will and testament, In witness whereof I have to this my last will
and to every page thereof set my hand & seal the Ninth Day of
May in the year of our lord god one thousand six hundred twenty one
and published and declared by fame in the presence of

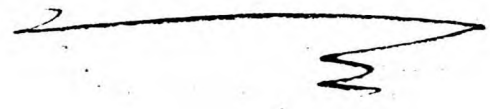
