RULES GOVERNING COMPETITIONS

- The Exhibitor agrees to abide by the Rules laid down by the Committee, which are final.
- 2. All Entries must be made on the Entry Forn in Schedule, accompanied by an Entrance Fee of 3d., except Section 1, 1/-, Sections 2 and 3 6d.
- Competitors must send their Entries, together with Entry Fees, to the Secretary, 67 Eastgate Street, Cowbridge, not later than Wednesday, 20th September, 1944. No Entries will be accepted after that date.
- 4. All Exhibits to be staged before 1 p.m. on the day of the Show, wher the Hall will be cleared and only those with official duties will be allowed inside.
- All Exhibits must have been the bona fide property of the Exhibitor for not less than two months before the Show, and to have been grown by him or her in his or her allotment or garden.
- 6. The judges may withhold any prizes if they think the Exhibit is not of sufficient merit.
- 7. Only one prize may be awarded where the Exhibits in any one class do not exceed three.
- Any objection must be made in writing and handed to the Secretary on the day of the Show, accompanied by a deposit of 2/6, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- The Committee do not hold themselves responsible for any loss or damage to Exhibits, but will endeavour to take all possible care.
- 10. Tables, etc., will be provided, but Exhibitors must provide all the necessary material for staging.
- 11. Any Exhibitor using unfair means to secure a prize, will forfeit claim to all prizes that may have been awarded to him or her.
- 12. The Committee reserve the right to settle any dispute which may occur for which these Rules do not provide.
- 13. The Committee reserve the right to object to any Exhibit.
- 14. Each Exhibitor will be responsible for the placing of Class Cards on the Exhibit. Any Exhibit without Class Card will be disqualified.
- 15. No Exhibitor shall make more than one entry in any Class.
