

Curland (old Post Office), Llanblethian

- 1840 Thomas Bassett owned; David Richards occupied, cottage and garden *Tithe 224*
- 1851 David Richards, farmer of 26 acres, employing one *Census 24*
- 1852 Mr R Bassett owned; David Richards occupied *R13 2/5*
- 1861 David Richards aged 72 (and Butlers) and grandchildren *Census 42*
- 1871 ? John Richards and Bennet Edwards *Census 40*
- 1874 Bennett Edwards occupied; R Bassett Esq. owned, house and land, 15 acres etc
County rate
- 1880 Conveyance, David Williams of Aberthin, builder, to Jane Edwards of Broadway,
near Cowbridge – farmhouse with barn, stables etc. (tithe nos. 200, 218, 223, 224
and 236) occupied by Benuel Edwards *Aberthin deeds, 136, NLW*
- 1895 Henry Williams *‘Llanblethian in 1895’ – Robert Thomas*
- 1910 T. Williams etc owned, house and garden near factory *PRO/VAL/1/46*
