Any points not set forth in these conditions, will be settled by the Committee whose decision is final.

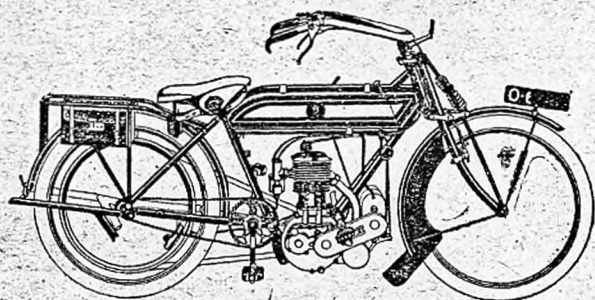
A fee of 2/6 must accompany each objection, which amount will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained. Objections must be reported to the Committee immediately.
