

Trebettyn

- 1786 Mr William Lewis *Llanblethian tithe accounts*
- 1789 Joseph Lewis “
- 1790 - 96 John Lewis “
- 1845 - 1870 William Lewis of Llanquian, then Llwynceelin, owner (farm tenanted)
- WAH Fisher (Book 27)* refers to a William Lewis of Llanquian who died in 1855 aged 53. He left a place on his left at his grave for his illegitimate son ‘begotten in body of his cousin who lived with him in his bachelor days at Trebettin’.
- 1814 Five closes of arable meadow and pasture called Dwyr Trebettin (about 4 acres), Erw a hanner (about 2 acres), Erw y hanner (about 2 acres) in the parish of Llanblethian in the occupation of Jonathan Mazey as yearly tenant – owner James Maxse (possibly the steward is R Mumford of Trebettin and Maindy House)
D/D Aubrey 34-38
- 1870 Sale of Trebettyn *Western Mail*
- 1872, 28th October Mr John Thomas favoured with instructions from Mr Wm Tilley, who is giving up farming, to sell by auction stock, crops, implements – Trebettin Farm, nr Cowbridge *County Glamorgan Gazette*
- 1881 -1889 William Tilley, owner, house and land at Trebettyn *Register of electors*
- William Tilley was the father of Alderman David Tilley, who became mayor of Cowbridge. William, from Wiltshire, moved from Trebettyn into Cowbridge west end where his family grew up.
- 1912 Marriage of Margaret Anne Rees of Trebettin *Llanblethian church records*
- 1919, February Tilley family sell Trebettyn (M A Tilley dies 1925)
