

Following an invitation from the Headmaster, Mr. J. Idwal Rees, to revive the Old Boys' Association, a Committee meeting was held at the School on 31 May '46 at 7 p.m. Those present were Messrs. D.T. Jones, O.H. Evans, O. Glyn Davies, C.J. Warren, D.H. Evans, D.R. Hammond, A.T. Brown and D.G. Williams. The Headmaster expressed regret at his inability to attend owing to illness and in his absence Mr. J.D. Owen kindly took the Chair. The Chairman expressed his great pleasure and that of the School, in seeing so many present, and outlined the reasons for calling the meeting. A letter from Mr. G.R. Herapath was read, in which he expressed his regret to continue as Secretary in view of his present domicile in England and his future business commitments.

It was resolved that Mr. D.G. Williams be appointed as Secretary. The Secretary was instructed to write to Mr. G.R. Herapath thanking him for his past services, and to Mr. Carne Williams to ascertain the financial position of the Association. It was unanimously agreed that a general meeting of the Old Boys' Association should be held, after the Old Boys' Cricket Match on 20 July '46, at 7.30 p.m. in the School. The following recommendations were made for submission to the General Meeting:-

1. That a Committee be appointed consisting of one member for each area and that the Captain of the School be invited as a co-opted member.
2. That O.Bs be asked to pay an annual subscription of 2/6, but in the case of those O.Bs desirous of copies of the *Bovian* as published, the annual subscription should be 5/-.
3. That O.Bs should be asked to raise a sum, not less than £500, for the provision of a suitable War Memorial.
4. That the War Memorial should take the form of a stained glass window in Cowbridge Church, similar to the one already there commemorating the O.Bs of the Great War and that an O.Bs Memorial Scholarship be founded.
5. That a special Committee should be set up to be known as the O.Bs War Memorial Committee.
6. That R. Williams, Esq., M.C., M.A., be elected a life member of the O.Bs Association.
7. That a dance be held in the Xmas term after the Old Boys' Rugger Match.
8. That the annual dinner be held in the Lent term.
9. That separate ^{sections} sections for Cricket and Rugger be appointed to select O.Bs teams.

It was unanimously agreed that Mr. D.R. Hammond be invited to act as Cricket Secretary,

There being no further business the Meeting was closed.

The first post-war general meeting of the Association will be held on Saturday, 20 July '46 in the Big Hall of the School at 7.30 p.m.
