"Henry's birth record was found at Town Hall, showing he was born on Market Street. Henry married twice. His first wife died leaving him with five children, then he married Elizabeth Griffith and they had four children together. Henry was a cattle buyer. He kept his cattle on a track of land near Aberdale that belonged to some of the family. He also operated a butcher shop and meat market in Merthyr. He was a prominent citizen and very active in the town and in the Methodist Wesleyan Society. He once lived at #1 Church Street, right next to "Miners' Hall", which used to be an old church that Henry helped finance. Upon the death of his wife Elizabeth, he left Merthyr in Jan 1894 to live with his son Phillip in Cowbridge. On leaving town he was given a farewell dinner; the adress was given by a Mr. Goodwin, at that time a Chancelier of the Exchequer."

John was captured (date unknown) and imprisoned in Andersonville. He was exchanged April 1, 1865. It is unlikely that he returned to his regiment, which would have been in North Carolina at that time, on it's way to Washington DC. More likely, he was discharged and returned home.

The 15th was from Boone Co, IL. War records give his residence first as Nora, then Lena, not no state is mentined. At that time, the border between IL and WI was farther north than it now is, so he could have been living in what is now southern Wisconsin and still be an Illinois resident.

Phillip moved to Cowbridge sometime between 1851 and 1860. His first wife was Isabella Randall. They had 3 daughters: Jane (b1860), Ada, and Louise. She died age 25, soon after he moved to #45 High Street, which was a grocery shop started by William Williams. By 1860/61, Phillip had taken it over and ran it until his death in 1910. Thereafter it was managed by his daughter Jane. It remained a grocery store until the 1960's.

Second wife was Jane (16 years his senior). She died age 65 in Cowbridge. Five years later, Philip's father Henry, lost his wife Elizabeth, and moved to Cowbridge to live with Philip. Philip would have been a widower when Henry came to live with him after Elizabeth's death in 1889. Ad: "P. Griffiths, agent for Dunmore's celebrated Cambridge sausages and pies, Gilbey's wines and spirits, Huntley and Palmer's biscuits, Crosse and Blackwell's manufacturers. A trial of his 1/8 d tea is solicited. Orders promptly attended to and delivered in the country weekly."

Notes from interviews conducted by Jeff Alden with older citizens of Cowbridge who had known the family:

From Mrs VJ Russell, Caxton House, Cowbridge 9abt 1977): I can remember we had a Band of Hope one evening a week, which the curate took, and Miss Loui Griffiths accompanied the singing on the piano. She lived in the grocer's shop on the corner of Verity's Court with her two sisters and father. She had charge, too, of the Sunday School Lending Library. She gave me pianoforte lessons. At Band of Hope we used to recite or sing at our weekly meetings.

From Mervyn Harkett, Love Lane (in 2000): Gomer Spencer, the son of the Spencers at the Mill in Llanblethian, worked for the Griffiths grocers who left the shop to him.

From Elgeva Thomas, St. Hilary (in 1999): Mr. Griffiths, grocer in High St. Two daughters - one was Miss Louisa. They came in horse and trap to St. Hilary, getting orders to be delivered two weeks later. Every Christmas, Mr. Griffiths used to come himself and present every customer with a quarter pound of Indian tea.

From Longmeadow Court residents (in 1998): Three sisters - Jenny, Louie, and Ada - lovely old souls. There was a lovely smell of fresh ground coffee and baked cakes.

From Mrs. G. Williams, Geoffrey Ashe Court (in 2001): Her mother, Miss Minnie Edmondes and Mrs. Davies, the curate's wife, who lived in the Easty end of Cowbridge, used t meet in the Griffiths' shop for a good gossip.

He was sent to Fort Howard Wisc to work int he Claims dept and then to Green Bay to work as a special agent (night watchman). He retired in 1912 at age 63. He died in 1935.

Per his granddaughter Gwen: everyone liked him. He loved his family and music. I can remember him very well when I would walk in the room and he'd always say, There's my honey-girl." He played and sang Welch hymns and all four of his children were musical.
