
## Appendix 4: The Mansell family and their connections with the greater gentry

\* Refers to those gentlemen who in 1694 signed an agreement regulating the horseracing on Ogmore Down (P&M 755). It specifies, for example, the weight carried, distance run, and value of the prize. Of ten signatories, nine belonged to the broad 'cousinship' of county society. The other, William Herbert of Friars, was almost certainly a 'cousin' of these families, but I cannot discover the exact relationship.
