The Llanblethian Parish Society

The above-named Society was founded at a meeting held on 2th November, 1962, at which some 25 people were present.

The meeting recognised that the considerable development of ne Parish during recent years would continue, and that a ontinuing growth in the population of the Parish is certain.

The objects of the Society are to preserve the appearance nd character of the village of Llanblethian as much as possible using its development, and to encourage the improvement of sisting amenities by such means as the planting of trees and the oncealment of eyesores.

At the same time, it is considered desirable to encourage reater community spirit by arranging social events.

The Society is seeking affiliation with the Council for the rotection of Rural Wales and the Civic Trust. And at the same me it will co-operate with the Rural District and Parish Councils.

The meeting elected Mr. Raymond Cory as Chairman, and r. G. A. Lloyd-Jones as Secretary. An Executive Committee imposed of the Rev. E. O. T. Lewis, Mr. Harry Thomas, Ir. Gorb, Mr. Pagnamanta, Mr. Havers, Mr. D. D. Muir, Mr. G. unter and Mr. W. Stone was also elected.

The work of the Society will be assisted by three submmittees, to which have been delegated the duties of 1. Liaison, Activities, and 3. Social and Publicity work.

It is hoped to issue a quarterly leaflet to members detailing e Society's efforts and reporting on matters of interest to the llage.

Membership is open to all residents in the Parish and also to tives, wherever they may now be, at a minimum annual subription of 2/6d., or 5/- for family membership.
