

# Fire, Fire! Tân, Tân!



The Borough Council established the town's first professional fire brigade in 1904. Each year the superintendent presented a report on the brigade to the council.

Superintendent Hayden presented the fourth annual report on the Borough Fire Brigade in 1910:

Number of calls received to fires for the year ending 31st March 1910: 24 (compared to 30 the previous year). Eight call outs to fires outside the borough. Time spent extinguishing fires: 106 hours and 5 minutes.

Brigade strength: 1 Superintendent, 1 Assistant Superintendent, 3 engineers and 7 firemen. There had been 16 drills during the year, totalling some 25 hours and 42 minutes of training.

Their appliances included:

- 1 steam fire engine
- 1 manual fire engine
- 1 fire escape
- 1 hose cart
- 8 scaling ladders
- 1,600 yards of canvas hose
- 4 lengths of leather hose
- 6 canvas buckets
- 7 stand pipes
- 3 hand pumps
- 1 hand chemical machine (a kind of fire extinguisher)
- 2 four in hand sets of quick hitching harness (to attach horses to the engines)
- 15 copper lamps
- 7 torches
- 1 life line, 100 feet
- 1 jumping sheet

All the kit was in good order except the hand hose cart, which was too heavy for the team to pull to a fire at any distance from the town centre.

Superintendent Hayden's report reflected the change in culture that accompanied the formation of a professional fire brigade. The era of the amateur was over.

Nifer y galwadau a dderbyniwyd at danau am y flwyddyn ddaeth i ben ar 31ain Mawrth 1910: 24 (mewn cymhariaeth â 30 y flwyddyn flaenorol). Roedd wyth galwad allan at danau oddi allan i'r fwrdeistref. Amser a dreuliyd yn diffodd tanau: 106 awr a 5 munud.

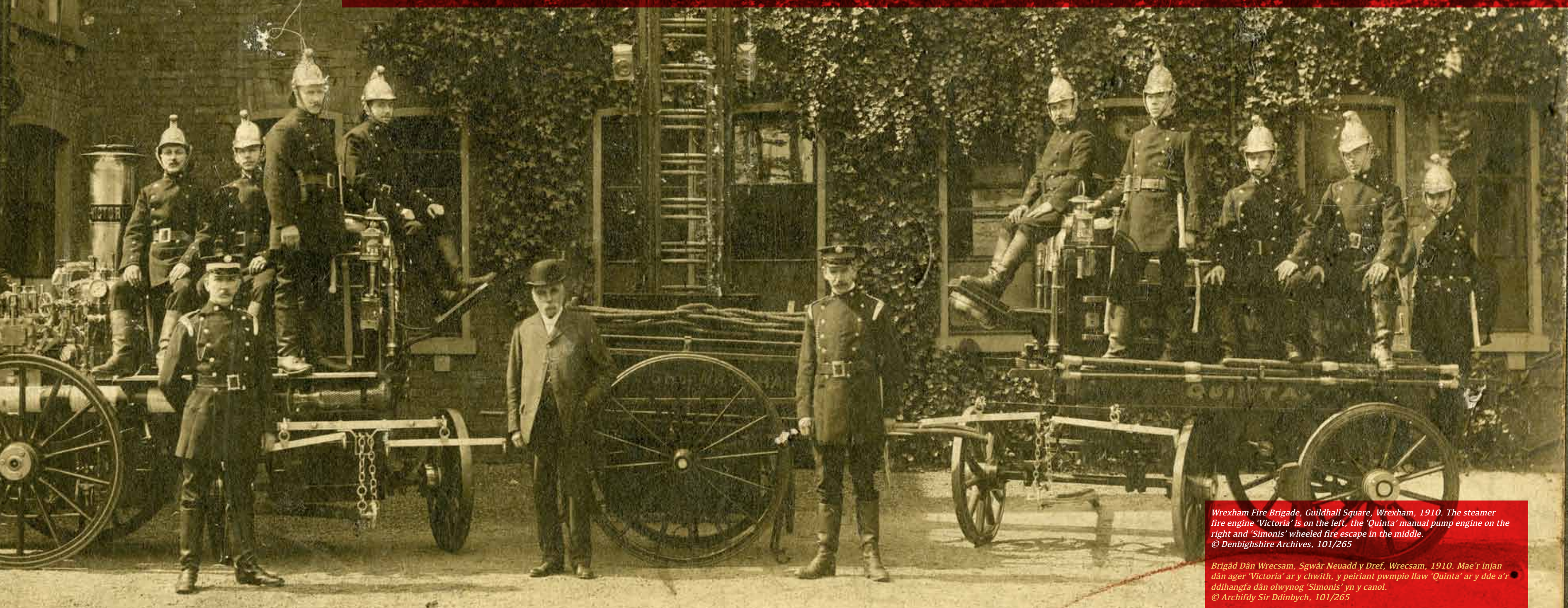
Niferoedd y Frigâd: 1 Uwcharolygydd, 1 Uwcharolygydd Cynorthwyol, 3 peiriannydd a 7 diffoddwr tân. Bu 16 o ddriliau yn ystod y flwyddyn, yn dod i ryw 25 awr a 42 munud o hyfforddiant.

- 2 set o harneisiau parod pedwar ceffyl (i gysylltu ceffylau â'r peiriannau)
- 15 lamp gopr
- 7 torsh
- 1 rhaff achub, 100 troedfedd
- 1 cynfas neidio

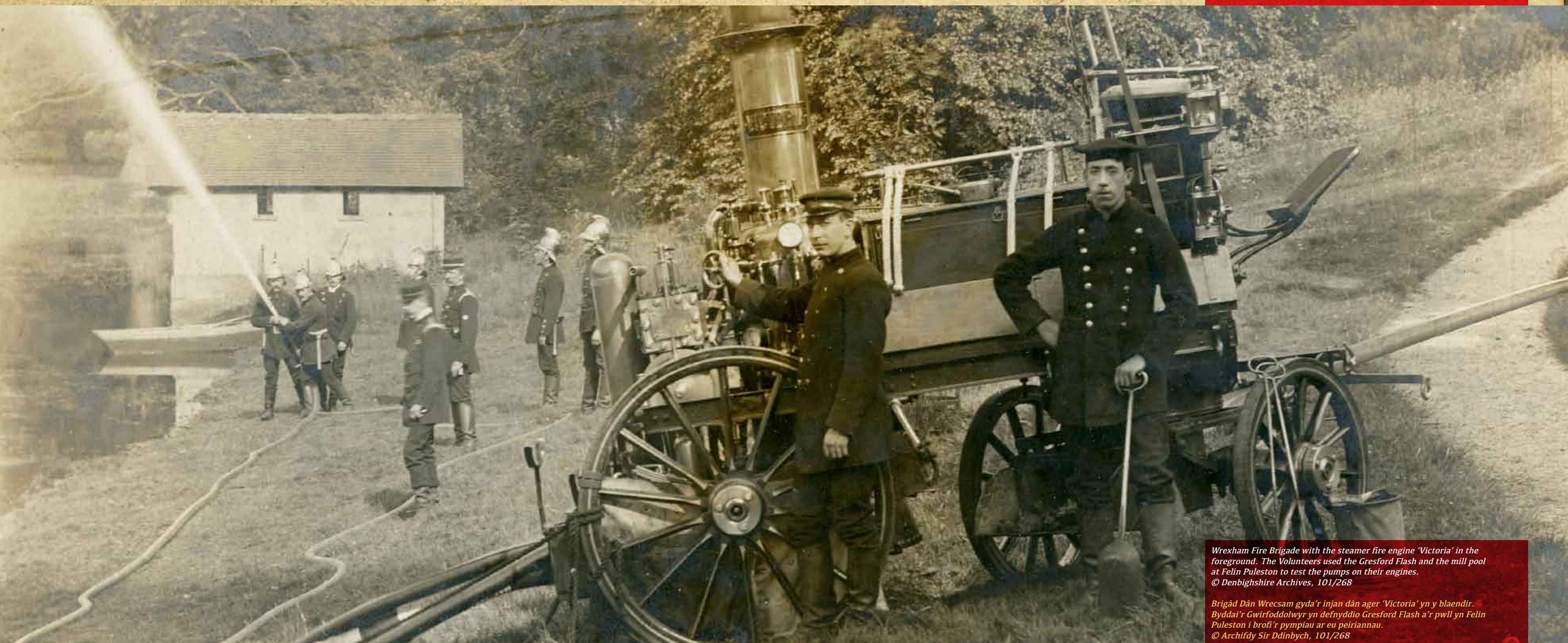
Roedd yr holl daclau mewn cyflwr da heblaw cert law'r bibell ddŵr, oedd yn rhy drwm i'r tim ei thynnu at dân unrhyw bellter o ganol y dref.
